



## What is the Indian Boarding Homes Class Action?

Program placed First Nations and Inuit children in private homes for the purpose of attending school. This Settlement provides compensation to people placed in these homes. You are a Primary Class Member if Canada placed you in a private home, between September 1, 1951 and June 30, 1992. You may still be eligible if you were placed after June 30, 1992. People who were placed in private homes, but died on or after July 24, 2016, may also be eligible, and their estate can apply on their behalf.

## How can I know if I am eligible?

## What is the deadline to apply?

You have to apply before February 22, 2027.

## How can I start my Application?

# Were you sent away from home to go to school?

If you or someone you know was taken from home to attend school in Canada and lived with another family, you could be eligible for up to \$200,000.

## Lawyers are available to help you.

The Claims Administrator will pay a set fee for a lawyer to help you with your CAT2 claim. This money will NOT come from your compensation.

### Estates are eligible.

Family members can apply for eligible loved ones who may have passed away.
